

## 25 Things That God Can Never Do

We know that God is omnipotent which mean He can do anything.

Jeremiah 32:17 says **“Ah Lord God! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! Nothing is too difficult for You!”**

In Genesis 18:14 Abraham was asked a question **“Is anything too hard for the Lord?”** If you are like me you would answer “No”. However, God is also holy and they are certain things that His holiness will not allow His to do – for our sake.

So as we thank God for the things He has done and can do, so should we thank Him for the things He can never do.

I have listed below a few things that God cannot do – for our benefit:

1. **God cannot lie.**

**Heb.6:18** – “That by two immutable things, in which *it was* impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:”

2. **God cannot bless a lie**

**Leviticus 19:11** – “Ye shall not steal, neither deal falsely, neither lie one to another.”

3. **God cannot be forced into an impossible situation** – He knows everything  
**Job 28:24** - For he looks to the ends of the earth and sees everything under the heavens.

**Hebrews 4:13** - And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

4. **Gods cannot love sin.**

**Habakkuk 1:13** - “You are of purer eyes than to behold evil, And cannot look on wickedness.”

5. **God cannot do anything contrary to the Scriptures.**

**Matthew 5:18** - "For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled."

**John 10:35** "...the scripture cannot be broken."

6. **God cannot change**

**Malachi 3:6** - “For I am the LORD, I change not;”

**James 1:17** - "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."

**Hebrews 13:8** - "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and for ever."

7. **God cannot recall our sins after we have asked for forgiveness.**  
**Isaiah 43:25** – “I, even I, am he who blots out your transgressions for my own sake; and I will not remember your sins.”  
**Micah 7:19:** “He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea”
8. **God cannot be unjust.**  
**Hebrews 6:10** - For God *is* not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward His Name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.
9. **God cannot be the author of confusion.**  
**1 Corinthians 14:33** – “For God is not *the author* of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.”
10. **God cannot revoke his gifts.**  
**Romans 11:29** - For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.
11. **God cannot leave us or forsake us.**  
**Deuteronomy 31:6** – “Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the Lord your God, he is the one who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you.”
12. **God cannot go back on His promises.**  
**2 Timothy 2:13** - “If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself”
13. **God cannot be pleased without faith.**  
**Hebrews 11:6** - "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him."
14. **God cannot give anything to double minded man.**  
**James 1:7-8** - "For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. A double minded man is unstable in all his ways."
15. **God cannot withhold wisdom from those who ask in faith.**  
**James 1:5-6** - "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed."
16. **God cannot be too big for our problems.**  
No prayer or thought is too simple or unnecessary for God to hear. He is not too busy for you.

**17. God cannot be too little for our problems.**

If God made the whole world what can be bigger than Him

**18. God cannot prefer one person over another.**

**Acts 10:34-35** – “In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality. But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him.”

**19. God cannot stop loving you.**

**Jeremiah 31:3** – “Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you.”

**20. God cannot break His covenants.**

**Psalms 89:34** – “My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of my lips.”

**21. God cannot get tired.**

**Isaiah 40:28** – “Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, neither faints nor is weary.”

**22. God cannot be late.**

**1 Samuel 13:1-14** – God was not late. The war had not even started yet before Samuel arrived!!

**23. God cannot be our problem.**

**Jeremiah 29:11** – “For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.”

**24. God cannot be against us.**

**Romans 8:31** – “What shall we then say to these things? If God *be* for us, who *can* be against us?”

**25. God cannot ignore the praises of his people.**

**Psalms 22:3** - “But thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel.”  
Praises not only move the hands of God, it moves God Himself

All the above points should paint a better picture of God’s attributes and His love for us so that we have a higher notion of our Heavenly Father. If we only have been meditating on the things that God can do, it is about time we started thanking Him for the things He cannot do – because those are also for our good.

The question now is - With these attributes of God in mind, will you count yourself as being blessed or will you still think your blessings don't count?
